

## Staff Spotlight Makuena Lintsa



I'm Makuena Lintsa, the Grade 4/5 homeroom teacher at Banjul American International School—and a proud mom of a Pre-K student here! This is my second year at BAIS, but my teaching journey began over 15 years ago. My career in American international schools started back in 2010, soon after I graduated with a Bachelor of Education. Since then, I've gained a background in Learning Support and completed my Master's in Teaching Mathematics, which allows me to approach learning with a focus on both support and enrichment.

In our class, I teach Physical, Social, and Emotional Learning (PSEL) along with Language Arts, where we are currently reading *Esperanza Rising* to sharpen analytical skills and exploring the Universal Declaration of Human Rights to foster empathy and critical thinking. In Math, we're focused on number sense, place value, and operations, with Grade 5 students diving into decimals and Grade 4 concentrating on whole numbers. In Science, we're exploring Physical Science based on Grade 5 NGSS and AERO standards, engaging students with hands-on, inquiry-based learning. Social Studies this term includes units on production, distribution, and consumption, along with essential themes like time, change, and continuity, and the influence of science, technology, and society.

Outside the classroom, I enjoy connecting with fellow educators about teaching and discussing ideas that spark curiosity about the world. In my downtime, I love reading, spending quality time with family, sampling pastries, and traveling to discover new cultures.
